Pioneer Life: Father's Life History [does not give his name!]

We left our home - down 5726 (c+) - 52 wds -

We depended mainly on fish & food

Cold Hollow, a low divide c 20 m long bet SP + NP River
terminating abruptly at its north end where it intersects the NP -
We crossed to SP at Lone tree Ferry, above 6 miles below the end
of the hollow, then cut to road now. The Leap of Life was
a bluff 75 or 100' high across - back at the mouth of a cut where
it intersected the NP, over which a band of Indians escaped
capture of Gen Paul Kearny.

CTR approx. 80 rods of road - actually an 8-10 m.
